**Scholarships to continue your education are available!**

The Aurora Public Schools Education Foundation administers numerous scholarship funds. All of the current scholarships are described on the attached page. As you review the opportunities, please keep the following things in mind:

- All of the scholarships listed will be awarded to **Aurora Public Schools' students**. **You MUST be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen to apply for APSEF scholarships.**
- All the applications are available through your school's counseling office and the Aurora Public Schools Education Foundation website at [www.apsedfoundation.org](http://www.apsedfoundation.org). **NEW THIS YEAR: Applications MAY be submitted online, or may be completed from a computer and then printed.**
- **New scholarships are still being created, so check back** with your counseling office or our website ([www.apsedfoundation.org](http://www.apsedfoundation.org)) to learn about new scholarship opportunities.
- **Applications are due Monday, March 2, 2009 by 4:00 p.m.** It is to your benefit to begin and complete the application process early.
- The scholarships are designed to fit the needs of many different students. **You do not have to be in the top ten or twenty percent to apply.**
- **Letters of recommendation may be copied and submitted with more than one application.** Please make sure the person writing your recommendation knows this if you intend to use their letter more than once.
- **Each applicant should submit 6 complete packets of each scholarship application if you are not completing the application on-line.** Please submit one (1) complete original application (application form, essay, letters of recommendation, and unofficial transcript) and five (5) complete copies. Collate and staple the original as well as all copies. APSEF must receive all six (6) packets by 4:00 p.m. on Monday, March 2, 2009.
- **You cannot be considered if you don't apply.**
- Our goal is to see as many students as possible have the opportunity to compete for the scholarships.
