Advantage Security Scholarship (New Scholarship this year!)

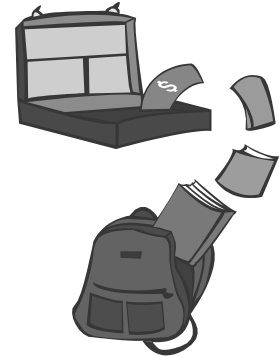
- One \$500 scholarship award
- Accepted at an accredited college/university/technical school
- Minimum 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale

Aurora Schools Federal Credit Union Scholarship

- Four \$1000 awards (1 per school – Aurora Central, Gateway, Hinkley and Rangeview)
- Two \$500 awards (1 per school – William Smith and Pickens Technical College)**
- 2.5 -3.5 minimum grade point average**
- Scholarship may be used to pursue a career in any field
- Currently involved in community service activities

Davis Teen Parent Scholarship

- Two \$500 scholarship awards
- Available to seniors who are teen parents only**
- Selection based upon involvement in school or community service activities and financial need



Elinor Knapp Scholarship for Girls

- One \$1,000 scholarship award
- Available to senior girls at all high schools
- Scholarship to be used to pursue a career in any field
- Must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average

Gerkin Family Expository Writing Scholarship

- Two \$500 scholarship awards
- 3.0 minimum grade point average
- Accepted at an accredited college/university/technical school
- Complete an Expository Portfolio

Jack Knapp Memorial Scholarship

- One \$1,000 scholarship award
- Involved in humanitarian/charitable activities and/or overcome physical, mental, or learning handicap
- Scholarship to be used to pursue a career affecting the greater good or for pursuing special needs education
- Must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average

Mary Jane Kohler Scholarship for Promising Educators

- Two \$500 scholarship awards
- Must be planning a career in education
- Must have a 3.2 grade point average or better
- Selection based on academic achievement, leadership potential, and activities

Nora Jane Crocker Redding Memorial Scholarship

- One \$2,000 scholarship award
- Must be planning a career in education
- Selection based upon character, standards, sense of humor and a 1,000-word essay
- Must have a minimum 3.0 grade point average



Wells Fargo Student Scholarship

- Two \$500 scholarship awards
- 2.0 minimum grade point average
- Gained admission into a vocational school or college/university

AURORA CENTRAL STUDENTS ONLY

Myrtle Replogle Travis and Russell Romayne Travis Memorial Scholarship

- One \$2,000 scholarship award
- Selection based upon financial need, goals, values and a 1,000-word essay
- Must be in top half of class

GATEWAY STUDENTS ONLY

Gateway Friends of the Performing Arts Deborah E. Downing Memorial Scholarship

- One \$500 scholarship award
- Gateway High School student involved in performing arts program
- 3.0 minimum grade point average



T. Matt Hirschfeld Scholarship

- One \$500 scholarship per year for a student attending a 4 year school OR \$1,000 per year for a student attending a 2 year school. (total award equals \$2,000).
- Selection based upon character, sense of humor, concern for others and brief responses to four questions
- Must have a 2.0 grade point average or better
- Reward for average students

Laura Soroko Memorial Scholarship

- One \$1,000 scholarship award
- Scholarship to be used to pursue a career in education
- 3.0 minimum grade point average

Rucker Rewards Scholarship

- One \$1,250 scholarship award
- 2.3-3.0 minimum grade point average
- Student currently works 20 hours per week outside of school
- Student regularly participates in church or other religious activities

HINKLEY STUDENTS ONLY

Charles C. Morrison Scholarship

- One \$1,500 scholarship award
- Scholarship must be used to pursue a career in education
- 2.5-3.5 minimum grade point average
- Essay topic- "I want to be a teacher because....."

Hinkley Alumni Scholarship

- One or more \$500 scholarship (dependent on additional contributions) awarded
- Accepted at an accredited college/university/technical school
- No minimum grade point average required – open to ALL Hinkley graduating seniors

RANGEVIEW STUDENTS ONLY

2Lt. Chris Steitz Scholarship

- Two \$1,500 scholarship awards
- Wholesome influence on others
- 3.0 minimum grade point average
- Preference to students who plan to study aviation or has a parent in active military duty (or retired military)
or public safety officer (police, sheriff, fire, EMT)
