Basket Pad Notes

Description

This application provides as many baskets (drawers) as you wish; Several kinds of objects (texts, URLs, images,...) can be drag-n-drop'd into it.

Objects can be edited, copied, dragged... So, they can be arranged according to users' taste. Moreover, Basket allows you to keep all objects you want in one place, keep data on hand, take notes...



Why use it?

- Great for keeping track of information locally

How to install: Applications > Add/Remove > search for “basket” >

check the box for “Basket Pad Notes” and apply changes. NOTE: make sure you see “all available applications” not “installed applications only.”

Where is it?: Applications > Accessories > Basket Note Pads

How to install: Sign up at www.xmind.net,

Download XMind 3 Debian/Ubuntu – DEB, Double-click on the package and install using “debi.”
